Impact of 2020 Census Redistricting of Congressional Districts, State Senate Districts, and Formation of Single Delegate Districts in WV

Apportionment is the process of dividing the 435 seats in the U.S. House of Representatives among the 50 states. Because West Virginia lost about 0.6% of its population between 2010 and 2020, while the total U.S. population grew, West Virginia lost one representative. The state was divided into **two Congressional Districts** instead of three. The State Legislature determined the boundaries; the **First District** is in southern West Virginia, the **Second District** in the north. All precincts in Monongalia County are in the **Second Congressional District**.

In 2021 the State Legislature enacted maps for the WV Senate and House of Delegates. Based on a 2018 law, the legislature created single delegate districts throughout the state; the new maps divided Monongalia County into 6 districts (one delegate per district). These new maps and districts go into effect for the 2022 legislative elections.

Monongalia County is divided into two **State Senate districts** in Monongalia County with two senators per district, as follows:

State Senate District 2 – The 2nd District spans three counties and parts of three others, including western Marion and northern and western Mon into Morgantown. Precincts in Monongalia County are: 40, 44, 47, 51, 51-M, 52, 58, 59, 67, 73, 77, 78, 79, 81, 82, 83

State Senate District 13 – The 13th District runs along the I-68 corridor from Morgantown to Fairmont. Precincts in Monongalia County are: 1, 2A, 2B, 10, 13, 16, 23, 25, 26, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 38, 61, 62, 63, 64, 68, 71, 72, 74, 75, 86

There are six delegate districts in Monongalia County, as follows:

House of Delegates

District 77 – The 77th covers the entire western half of the county. Precincts 40, 44, 47, 51, 51-M, 52, 58, 59, 62, 64, 67, 68, 72, 73

District 78 – The 78th covers the eastern portion of Mon, between Cheat Lake and Browns Chapel. Precincts 1, 33, 38, 61, 63, 77

District 79 – The 79th covers part of Morgantown and South Hills. Precincts 2A, 2B, 10, 30, 35

District 80 – The 80th includes Suncrest, Star City, and Granville.

Precincts 23, 25, 26, 36, 71, 74, 75

District 81 – The 81^{st} covers the area that includes the WVU Research Park and the Airport. Precincts 13, 16, 32, 86

District 82 – The 82nd covers the Cheat Lake area from the Monongahela River to the Preston County Line. Precincts 31, 34, 78, 79, 81, 82, 83

The LWV of Morgantown-Monongalia County is currently focusing on the following issues:

Voters Service: Support non-partisan redistricting efforts; oppose restrictions on voter registration; oppose voter ID requirements that present barriers to voting; and advocate for ways to increase voter turnout, based on lessons learned from recent elections.

Social Justice: Identify and collaborate with governmental and non-governmental organizations to make social justice principles a reality in Morgantown and Monongalia County; oppose legislative efforts to suppress civil and Constitutional rights; and advocate for state and Federal legislation to protect LGBTQ rights.

Environmental Protection: Protect the planet along with the health and safety of all West Virginians. Advocate for environmental priorities that are coupled with a creative and just transition for workers in fossil fuel industries, and oppose facilities that add, expand, or preserve dependence on fossil fuels.

Dues of \$48.00 for an individual, \$72.00 for a household (2 persons), and \$5.00 for a student are required annually. Dues may be sent to Shirley Rosenbaum, 531 Woodland Circle, Morgantown, WV 26505.
